

**The Bikeability Trust Get Cycling in Schools Prize Draw 2026
Terms & Conditions (updated January 2026)**



1. By entering the prize draw you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.
2. The prize draw is being run by the Bikeability Trust.
3. The prize is supplied by the Bikeability Trust.

Eligibility and how to enter

4. The prize draw is open to Get Cycling leads who:
 - I. Complete delivery of at least one module with pupils at their school, including
 - II. Record the completion of the module on Link or via the GCiS app, and
5. By doing the above between 1 January 2026 and 31 July 2026, you will be automatically entered into the prize draw to win the prize for your school.
6. A maximum of one entry per Get Cycling lead is permitted. (However, multiple Get Cycling leads at each school may enter, so the more Get Cycling leads who complete and record a module, the greater the chance of their school winning.) Schools who have already won pedal cycles are unable to win anymore.
7. There is no cost to enter.

The prize

8. 2 winners every month will receive a set of two children's pedal cycles for their school, and two helmets.
9. The winners will be drawn at random using a random number generator.
10. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferrable and no cash alternatives will be offered.
11. We reserve the right to substitute prizes with another prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond our control make it necessary to do so.
12. The winner selection is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
13. The winners will be chosen and contacted via email within 21 days of the closing date.
14. If the winner does not respond to the messages notifying them of their win within 14 days of receipt, they will lose their right to the prize, and the Bikeability Trust reserves the right to choose and notify a new winner.
15. Pedal cycles must be used to deliver the 'Learn to Ride' and 'Ride' modules. Evidence of this (for example by recording delivery on Link) is expected; if no evidence is provided the Bikeability Trust reserves the right to reclaim and redistribute the cycles.

16. Schools will be required to store and maintain the cycles. If schools wish to insure the cycles this will be their responsibility to arrange and pay for.

Receipt of the prize

19. To claim their prize, the winner must confirm delivery details to amy@bikeabilitytrust.org.
20. Please allow 30 days for delivery of the prize or alternative collection or delivery arrangements may be made through mutual agreement.

Data protection and publicity

21. You consent to any personal information you provide to Link being used by the Bikeability Trust for the purposes of administering the prize draw.
22. Participants may be asked to take part in publicity activities, but their acceptance is not a requirement of the promotion.

23. The Bikeability Trust does not accept any liability for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrants as a result of either participating in the prize draw or being selected for a prize.
